Safety First

Read, understand and follow all directions before beginning any job. **Always turn off electronic devices before starting.** A dark screen will show fingerprints and dirt easier than a bright screen. Read, understand and follow all directions before beginning. Consult the operators manual for special instructions. **Wear appropriate protective safety glasses. To prevent slipping, avoid over spray on smooth floor surfaces.**

Q: Should you spray any fluid directly on an electronic device?


A: For absolute safety and to protect your electronic component, No. However, some devices are built to withstand the elements and severe weather. Cell phones, ATMs, some GPS devices designed to be used out of doors are manufactured with waterproof membranes to protect the electronic circuitry from fluids. Always check your owners manual to be sure.

Portable Electronic Devices

You can clean the screen and case with Brillianize. Spray a corner of your cleaning cloth with several pumps of Brillianize. Using horizontal and vertical strokes remove the dust, dirt and fingerprints from the surface. Turn your cloth to a dry portion and polish the surface using horizontal and vertical strokes until all the fluid is gone and the surface is clean and smooth. For best results clean the screen weekly.


LCD, plasma, DLP and projection screens

Always apply when the surface is cool. Turn electronics off before spraying. Spray a corner of your cleaning cloth with several pumps of Brillianize. **Using horizontal and vertical strokes** remove the dust, dirt and fingerprints from the surface. Turn your cloth to a dry portion and polish the surface using horizontal and vertical strokes until all the fluid is gone and the surface is clean and smooth. For best results clean the screen weekly.



Very large screens

Don't try to clean the whole screen in one operation. Divide the screen into smaller manageable sections repeating the process until the whole screen has been cleaned. Be sure to use a clean, lint free polishing cloth to remove all the fluid.



Note: The removal of non-water soluble marks such as paint or nail polish may damage your screen or screen shield. Always use a clean, lint free cloth. **DO NOT SCRUB.** For lenticular screens, always wipe gently using up and down strokes in the direction of the grooves.
